Readers will put their names in for a weekly prize drawing each 100 minutes recorded on their reading log. (We are hoping readers spend 20 minutes 5 times a week reading or listening.) A special incentive is awarded when 400 minutes are recorded. When 500 minutes of reading are recorded a certificate will be issued for presentation on August 7.

This summer reading program and its goals are to encourage regular reading and to create lifelong readers. Did you know that reading as few as four books during the summer will help kids maintain vocabulary and familiarity with story lines? If the goals are too low, please negotiate with your child to raise them.

There is NO EXCUSE for saying “I’m bored” this summer!
