- The New Boston bid process has begun. Chief Hall and Moto Maguire vetted the ambulance. It is in very good shape. Chief Hall will be meeting with the Selectboard on this soon.
- Tyler Chillelli has been away for a bit so he hasn't been able to work on the Vehicle Cleaning & Inventory Roster but will do so now.
- MAFCA Training Committee – Chief Hall is the chair of the committee to develop the new regional volunteer firefighter training program. It will be approximately 80 hrs. The committee is hoping to run its first program this fall. Deputy LaCourse mentioned that regular training could be set up to supplement this program but the Chief was concerned that this might take those taking the course away from home too many nights a week.

- Hep B Shots – This is a 3 shot series over 6 months. GFD will pay for them. If you have had one, it is good for life. If we have 5 people that want them, someone from MCH will come to Greenfield to give them. If under 5, those who want it will have to go to MCH for them.

- Captain Lange also reported that there are issues with the SP02 monitor. A new one costs about \$500. More Narcan and Epi-pens came in. There will be some new i-gel airways coming in soon.
