7. OLD BUSINESS:

- Sunday Morning Church at GFD 9 am to 11 am. Open to all members who can attend.
- IDS: Chief Hall handed out the first 11 cards. Karen will take pictures of those without them this evening. Chief Hall also handed out green tags to be attached to bunker coats. A second set will be on the truck for accountability.
- GFD Roadrace: Stephanie Babb sent a letter outlining the help she will need the day of the race (29th). Lieut. Simmons will take care of getting the flag on the ladder truck. Tyler Chillelli, Pete Censabella, and Garrett Prince will staff the Rescue. Garrett and Pete will also help Friday night with the scaffolding. There will be a number of things to do Saturday morning: Garrett, Lieut. Batty, EMD Martin, Deputy LaCourse and Kelsea Dubey volunteered to help. Chief Hall will emcee on Saturday and will also bring the sound system. We need at least one more person for the GFD team. Captain Lange, Fire Warden Hennessey, and Kelsea Dubey volunteered. Kyle O'Dowd is already signed up and added his wife, Jessica. Stephanie's daughter Emma will also run. It is rumored that Jaffrey, Hancock, and Peterborough will all send teams to compete.
- The Ram tool is coming this week.
- The overhead doors should be finished by Wednesday. The electrician is fixing all the lights in the bays for the first time in a long time, they will all work.
- The run tally for last month was 25 – that makes 79 for the year so far.
- Tyler said that the extractor is operational now and he suggested that people do their gear on duty night. Deputy LaCourse suggested taking pictures of removing the liner from the gear for reference because getting it back in can be difficult.

8. NEW BUSINESS:

- The airpack batteries will be here shortly. We'll put them in on Sunday.
- Captain Lange talked about Rescue training on Tuesday. We've been through a certification cycle. If you have questions, ask Captain Lange. You can do NHOODLE and find plenty of good courses. The NREMT website is tough to work with. Chief Hall asked Captain Lange to do an inservice at some point. Captain Lange suggested putting in info as we go. If you miss a class, you can always go to another town to take it.
- Deputy LaCourse asked for a list of classes to recert next year. Chief Hall put Captain Babb in charge of this. It needs work but some of the officers will help.
- Live burn: There was a nice turn out on April 2nd in Lyndeborough. Those who went gave a synopsis of their experience. It was considered to be a good day and they learned a lot. Chief Brian Smith called Chief Hall to thank the department for going and helping out.

9. Announcements: There will be a live burn here and another in Lyndeborough soon.

Everyone thanked Fire Warden Hennessey for bringing dinner.

10. Dinner for May: Pete Censabella will make dinner for the May meeting.
