- Shelby Pagan was up for consideration to be a full member. The vote was unanimous. The Chief recused himself from this vote.
- Dep. LaCourse said that they attempted cleaning 4 dry hydrants but need some new fittings. He and Lieutenant Chilelli will draw up a list of what we need to order. Fire Warden Hennessey offered to help convert some of them to make them all a uniform size.

**10. GRANT PROPOSALS:**

- We are still being considered for the exhaust system grant. It is under review and we will get the answer very soon.
- We received a grant application for wildlands. Fire Warden Hennessey said that the State Fire Warden would like everyone to have a helmet, pants that fit, and gloves made of Nomex. This grant could cover that as well as the trash pump. The grant has a 50% match. Fire Warden Hennessey asked everyone to send him their sizes for these items. He also said that everyone should keep a spare pair of boots next to their gear; no sneakers, no steel toes, no bunker boots. There is a drought expected in July. He also asked if everyone was receiving the notices. No one was so he will make sure that this is corrected.
- Anna Voglino suggested head lamps for the wildlands grant. Fortunately, Lieutenant Simmons just got 16 of them from Monadnock Hospital.
