- **APPARATUS REPORTS:**
  - 13 Rescue 1: In service – has some lights out – sent list to Moto
  - 13 Rescue 2: In service - the Zoll in the rescue is not up to FDA standards, Portable AED is to be added
  - 13 Engine 3: In service -

  - CMRC alarm issues: there is an outside light when an alarm goes off. If you get the call to 1 Verney Drive, change the radio frequency to CMRC maintenance. This is a new protocol.
