- **APPARATUS REPORTS:** Items mentioned need attention
 - 13 Rescue 1: In service – Needs tire checked
 - 13 Rescue 2: In service – Air leak fixed
 - 13 Engine 3: In service – lightbulb in a clearance light, mirrors need to be replaced
 - 13 Tanker 1: In service – will be serviced in April
 - 13 Ladder 1: In service – will be serviced in April
 - 13 Brush 1: In service – still needs siren, windows & door handles to be fixed, needs water topped off
 - 13 Boat 1: In service – needs lights – winterized
 - 13 Boat 2: In service – needs lights – winterized
- **TRAINING:**
 - **1 Jan 12th EMS Training** – 18:30 – EMS scenarios
 - **3 Jan 19th Fire Training** – First 20 minutes
 - **Reminder: EMS cards up in February & March**
- **GRANT STATUS:** Emergency generators won't be in the AFG grant. They have been de-prioritized. Grant ideas included a base station radio, radios for the trucks, siren for the building, vehicle repeater, and air packs. The consensus was for air packs.
