Monthly meeting is July 11th due to the July 4th holiday being the previous Monday.

- Thursday nights camp firewood splitting: 6 7:30pm (On Memorial Day weekend, \$435.11 profit was made, and the past weekend another \$100. The Chief stated he believed there will be \$5000. by the end of the summer.)
- The Chief mentioned that he had a discussion with Dave Martin about trying to make use of the time during which the meetings were held. They want to try bite-size fire trainings on each meeting night. The Chief stated that he thought it should only take 20 minutes or so. This evening's training was on fire behavior and suppression during the first 15 minutes of a structure fire.

8. OLD BUSINESS:

- There was a reminder that we do have Sunday Morning Church at GFD 9 am to 11 am. Open to all members who can attend.
- <u>Fire Training Building Committee:</u> A select group of area Chiefs and Chief Hall have visited a fire facility in Brentwood and were also going to Nashua on the 8th and then to Springfield Mass.
- <u>Grant Writing:</u> Same information as presented in the agenda. Doug also stated that the State Farm Grant is available for health and safety equipment and that we need to figure out what firefighters need to stay healthy. Some discussion was held about gym equipment, but there wasn't room for storage.
- GAP Insurance: Louise spoke about getting the forms passed in for the GAP insurance.
- <u>225 Celebration</u>: At the first aid station at Oak Park, the Chief suggested 2 hour blocks of time for coverage. Cpt. Lange will head it up by getting the stuff for the first aid station.
- Discussion was held regarding available staff for the 225th celebration. GFA will be discussing which staff is available on their team and when to report, etc.
- The color guard for the parade was discussed and it was decided that 3 to 5 need to be in the color guard. Dawn, Doug and Chief Hall.
- Dave Simmons will drive the ladder truck by himself.
- Karen Day will go and get a sample of the t-shirts that she will be selling at the 225th. We will then go online and order. Karen stated that the shirt was \$2.74 with no ink and the finished order will be \$7.24 each. We will order 55, so will need \$165.00. We will be charging \$20.00 per t-shirt. The Chief suggested talking to Chris Borden, treasurer, to finish that.
- Cpt. Lange stated that the G.E.S. visit went great. He hasn't received any information. Dawn stated they showed them the rescue truck as well as how to call 911.

- Deputy LaCourse also asked if at church, can they work on putting more hose LDH onto engine 3.
- Cpt. Lange stated that if a person is on duty, DO NOT LEAVE FIREHOUSE UNLESS EVERYONE IS ACCOUNTED FOR IN THE RESCUE VEHICLE!
- There was a proposal on the table from the Chief that needed a vote:

 The Chief has been trying to get off the drill ground by 8 8:30 pm by the latest. He doesn't want the department to dread training, so he proposed that moving forward, all evening starts begin at 18:30 (6:30pm) instead of

7:00 pm. Vote was YES. The Chief will let KMA know.
