17	RWalling motioned to accept minutes as amended. Seconded by GRainier. Motion passed 7-0-0.

20	 Received current budget showing the planning board is within budget

22	 Received Building Permit for Native Construction, owner Tom Rosswagg, for Map R1 Lot 14-3
23	with excavation plans. They also included the building permit.

25	6:51 pm Reports from Other Board and Committees
26	MParker stated that the select board reviewed the LED Sign proposal and approved 2-1. They also
27	approved for the grant to purchase.
28	DThimmel explained that the farmer's market was canceled last weekend due to health concerns with
29	the weather.

31	7:00 pm Review Additional Old Bennington Road Plans
32	John Cronin, attorney for applicant Tom Rosswaag, and TRosswaag were both present to answer the
33	planning board's questions. JCronin explained this was a leftover lot which TRosswaag would like to
34	clear out to build a home. He went on to express his understanding that the materials would be moved
35	over a 2-year process. The planning board expressed their concern with the potential of 2000 plus tri-
36	axle loads of material being hauled over the narrow Old Bennington Rd and the possible damage such
37	could cause. RWalling requested that the applicant coordinate with the DPW once they have created a
38	hauling plan. TRosswaag will contact the DPW Director, Jim Morris to let him know of his plans.
39	GRainier recommended a site walk be conducted on the lot as it would be a good learning opportunity
40	for the board on excavation plans. RWalling motioned not to have a site walk. Seconded by DThimmel.
41	Motion passed 5-0-2. CMamczak and GRainier abstained.

43	6:42 pm Discussion, Proposals and Planning on Other Zoning Updates/Changes
44	The planning board went over the driveway permit application. RWalling will make the proposed edits
45	and will present to the planning board at the next meeting. The planning board further discussed

potential changes to ordinances. **RWalling** will contact town counsel to see what the planning board can and can not due with how current regulations and ordinances are written.
