25	Luke Chichester was present to go over his proposed business. He explained that he would like to open		
26	a mobile butcher shop with most, if not all, of the service being completed on his client's properties. He		
27	went on to state that he has a 6'x12' cooler trailer where he would be conducting his business, the small		
28	amount of processing done on his property would be in his workshop. LChichester has a contract with		
29	MD's Waste Removal to pick up any animal waste monthly, or sooner if needed. He has spoken with his		
30	direct neighbor and would be willing to have a privacy fence installed should this become a bother to		
31	anyone. LChichester explained that this would not be a USDA certified operation but would help small		
32	local farms. He would not have any scheduled hours but would be working roughly a 9am to 5-6 pm		
33	schedule. LChichester also expressed that chickens/turkeys would be processed on the client's property,		
34	where pigs and sheep would be done on the client's property first and completed in his workshop.		
35	The consensus of the planning board was that this would be a good benefit to the town and surrounding		
36	towns. RWalling motioned to approved this application and waive a site plan review. Seconded by		
37	DThimmel. Motion passed 7-0-0. The planning board thanked LChichester for his time.
