24	MParker explained his idea to create a separate application for minor and major site plan review
25	packets. The planning board went over the checklists and had a brief discussion. MParker is going to go
26	through the checklist, arrange it a little better and will present an edited checklist to the planning board.
27	RMarshall suggested that there be a 'not applicable' box to the checklist which could help the applicant.
28	RWalling recommend that the checklist be done at PCC meetings.

30	6:50 pm Site Plan Review Checklist for V1 Lot 9
31	MParker explained that the planning board will go over the site plan review checklist for V1 Lot 9. The
32	planning board had a discussion in regards to the requested waivers the applicant is asking for. MParker
33	motioned to accept the application. Seconded by RMarshall. Motion passed 5-0-0.

35	7:00 pm Public hearing – Site Plan Review – V1 Lot 9 – Raymond Cilley presenting
36	MParker opened the public hearing and went over the rules for the hearing. MHall stated that this
37	hearing was properly noticed to all abutters, in the newspaper, at the post office, at the town hall and
38	on the town's website. MParker asked for Raymond Cilley to present his plans. RCilley explained his
39	vision to restore the property to its original purpose as a black smith shop. He also suggested that the
40	building could be used for teaching, selling retail items, community work space, farmer's market and
41	community events with a food truck. MParker closed the public part of this hearing as there are no
42	members of the public present. The planning board has now entered a deliberative status. RMarshall
43	questioned the 25' wetlands buffer as it appears to go through the building and the entire property is in
44	the ground water protection district. RCilley suggested that maybe the buffer zone could be something

- 45 that he and the town work together on to improve the entire area. The planning board asked for **RCilley**
- to go before the ZBA to get a Special Exemption for the 25' wetlands buffer. The planning board went
- 47 over some restrictions within the ground water protection district, Section XIII Ground water
- 48 Protection Ordinance. It was decided that this proposal fit within the ordinance and that Letter G –
- 49 Prohibited Uses, #17 was not directed at this type of proposed activity. **RMarshall** motioned to approve
- 50 this site plan review conditional to: the Groundwater Conditional Use Permit to be filled out and signed,
- 51 the Code Enforcement Officer sign off on Fire and Safety, a Special Exception was granted by the ZBA, as
- 52 well as, a note added to the plans stating that acceptable deliveries are to the rear and east side access
- 53 points of the building. Seconded by MParker. Motion passed 5-0-0.
- 54 **RMarshall** thanked **RCilley** for the effort and enthusiasm that he has brought to this property, especially
- 55 in restoring the building to its original use. He believes that anyone could have come in and bulldozed
- the entire building down. He is very happy to see what **RCilley** continues to do with this property.
