The meeting was called to order at 7:00 pm by Chairperson Roger Lessard.

### Accept or Amend Previous Meeting Minutes

Karen motioned to accept minutes, seconded by Kate. All were in favor; motion passed.

### 2022 Budget Discussion

The GCC discussed the upcoming year's budget, deciding that it will request the same budget as it did last year, due to its 2021 plans being stymied by COVID-19 restrictions.

### Review Wetlands Map re: Slip Road Projects

The GCC discussed the proposed 60-acre timber cut on Slip Road (R6, Lot 8). A review of the wetlands map revealed that it contains far less wetlands than originally thought, and is not of extraordinary concern.

The Forest Society conducted a walk through the forest on October 14<sup>th</sup>.

### CNBRLAC Grant Application Recap

Roger reported that The Rivers Committee has decided not to put in for the grant this year, but may try next year.

### Pollinator Project – Meadow Park

Roger took down all the stakes around the planting and will replace with some wire he has. Autumn olive has sprung back with vigor. Roger will use the tool he purchased to uproot it.
