Business

Accept or amend previous meeting minutes. Candi motioned to accept the minutes as written. Seconded by Kate. All were in favor - 5-0 passed.

Old Business

Meadow Park: The GCC will sow clover, rather than go with the original plan.

- Seeding; Schedule removal of all plastic and weights Roger and Candi will remove and discard the plastic and weights May 20th at 4:30 pm.
- Decided on type of clover to sow The GCC decided to go with white clover, available at Achille Agway.
- Irrigating **Yet to be resolved,** Roger will talk with Ray Cilley to see about, however this wouldn't be much of an issue with clover as it doesn't require much attention.
- Planning and installing kiosk Possible change in location, this is still being discussed

Pollinator Pathway:

- Preparing bed for sowing zinnias The GCC will complete this project Saturday May 28th at 8:30am. They will first lay a roll of 3'x72' paper, followed by 2 yards of soil/compost mix.
- Irrigation plan for above They could use the pond behind the blacksmith shop or would likely be able to run a hose from the blacksmith shop with permission.
- Informing community about PP: Need for social media, The GCC discussed asking the Oak Park
 Committee to post about PP. Candi will reach out to Dave Thimmel from the Oak Park
 Committee.
- Designing, acquiring & disseminating PP participant yard signs work in progress
- Building and installing bluebird boxes in appropriate town-owned land TBD
- Publish lists of recommended pollinator-friendly plants and a time line of when they bloom –
 Link to town website?

Completing projects already begun:

Resume cleaning out our property from the old gym - Good start on March 20, **more work needed.** Karen and Roger have been working on this in spare time.

Wetlands Project

New Business:

- How to transfer money from conservation fund to pay Moosewood Ecological Roger talked with Catherine Shaw, money is removed and placed in the GCC budget. Roger suggests having a line item for these moneys.
- Site walk to Zephyr Lake Rd. This is tentatively scheduled for Sunday June 12th, 10 AM. Roger will schedule with the land owner.
- Consider temporary additional monthly GCC meeting to accommodate wetlands project This will be further discussed at the June meeting.
- GCC involvement at Sunset Lake? Because the town owns the beach, GCC will offer to join any effort to form a lake association.
