This plan reflects the warrant article funding level that the residents have voted for each of the past three years, from 2012-2014 (approx. \$125,000 for paving). This plan could be re-visited based on fund availability and/or road conditions. Road conditions are impacted by use, weather and/or weather related events, such as flooding and severe frost heaves.

The two roads not currently on this plan are Depot Road and Early American Drive; both are shorter roads with very low use. DPW will continue to assess these roads and pave them with funds from the road maintenance budget.

Greenfield DPW started a crack sealing program in 2013 and plans to increase the program in 2015 and beyond. Crack sealing prolongs the life of paved roads by inhibiting water from penetrating below the surface of the pavement: the freeze and thaw cycle of this water is a significant contributor to frost heaves.
