You DO NOT have to wait for those who are scheduled to show up. You need to respond to dispatch in this manner: . . . 13 Rescue 1 responding to (say the number and name of the street), all others respond to the scene. In doing so, you will save time and insure a prompt response to a very serious call, while repeating the address, updates those on their way. Also, if you are on a call that is a suspected stroke, please let dispatch know that this is a "Stroke Alert" call.
 - Monday, Sept. 7th is Frankestown's annual Labor Day Parade. If anyone is available to take an apparatus over to participate, please let the Chief know.
 - Rymes Gas Stations are closed and out of business. They are no longer selling gas, just oil and propane. The Chief is looking into alternatives for GFD fill ups.
