### 9. NEW BUSINESS:

- Louise Gryval asked for the new members to fill out the insurance paperwork
- Innoculations – for Hep B – Captain Batty and EMD Martin will handle this
- Nick Heckman will get a green front on his helmet
- A gated relief valve has been ordered
- SCBA Masks need identity tags – Chief Hall will order them. Caleb Black will get a list of names.

### Grant proposals:

1. Lowes Grant for a Prima Vent System for the truck bays. They will install it and paint the walls.
2. A used tanker from the US Government. It should be relatively new. The transfer cost will be minimal.
3. Dryer for turn-out gear out of Greenfield, MA
4. Wildland fire equipment

### 10. ANNOUNCEMENTS:

- Thank you to all who came to Fire Night. Your attendance helped us make the in-kind match for the Emergency Operations Plan grant.
- The Greenfield Fireman's Association will hold a Pancake Breakfast on July 22<sup>nd</sup>, 8-11 am. They need people to wash cars. Captain Borden will get a chamois.
- MCI Kits – Old kit is in Rescue 1, also Rescue 2, now fully equipped
- DPW Manager, Neal Beauregard resigned and Acting Manager is Todd Mason. His number is 554-7039
- Incidents – At the Father's Day 3 Alarm – members experienced heat related stress due to having gear on during the way down. Dress light under gear. Don't put water down your neck with your gear on. It can cause burns.
- There was a false alarm at Barbara C. Harris Camp at 3AM. Both an engine and rescue showed up. People were impressed by our turn out. Chief Hall was very proud of the department.
- Burn building: Was planned to be a concrete building and American Steel was going to help with the concrete walls. The Brentwood facility got shot down because they don't have new monitoring equipment. It costs about \$50,000. However, it is not needed with a wooden building. After the experience with the building at Oak Park, Chief Hall reconsidered. Now the Chief proposes building a ranch house each year at the Recycling Center. This could allow us to use it to train all summer, then burn it down and build it again in the spring. He is moving forward with this idea.
- Captain Batty met with Deputy Patrick to set up a joint EMS training. He will supply us with a list of necessary equipment.
