32	7:00 pm Review of Crotched Mountain Rehabilitation and Education District
33	RWalling explained that this is an informal meeting to discuss the district as the planning board is
34	looking over current districts. Fran Hurley, Chief Operating Officer for Gersh Holdings, was present to
35	answer questions from the planning board. FHurley explained that they took over November 2020, and
36	since have been updating the buildings on the mountain. He explained that there is no current plan to
37	build any new building, however there would be interest should the student numbers exceed over 120
38	students. FHurley went on to discuss the current businesses, they do not plan to have any businesses for
39	public use and would like to open other services to the public, as in the past, once Covid goes away.
40	The planning board discussed shrinking the Crotched Mountain District to Gersh's 120-acre parcels. The
41	planning board thanked FHurley for attending the meeting and providing information to the planning
42	board.
