MParker explained to the public present that this was entirely 34 the planning board's fault, because it had failed to send out the certified hearing notice letters to 35 abutters within the legally required 10-day lead time. To correct this potentially illegal oversight, the 36 planning board decided to reschedule and properly re-notice the Public Hearing for August 26, 2019 at 7 37 PM. MParker again apologized to the public in attendance for the inconvenience the planning board 38 had caused them, and explained that this change was not in any way the fault of the applicant 39 7:08 pm MParker closed the public hearing. 40 41 7:16 pm Unfinished Business- LLA Adjustment (Lot Line Adjustment) 42 MParker went over recent email exchanges he had with Mike Courtney, town counsel.
