Motion passed 6-0-0. 12 13 14 6:33 pm Mail: 15 January 2021 SWRPC Highlights 16 Return check and postage increase sheet 17 Receipt from Monadnock Ledger for tonight's public hearing. 18 Change of employment wages for clerk form, to be signed by MHall 19 20 6:34 pm Announcements 21 **GRainier** stated that the ZBA is meeting 2/28/21 at 6 pm to discuss the Gregg building permit proposal. 22 MParker stated that the EDAC (Economical Development Advisory Committee) is still meeting and will 23 be working on new items. MParker went on to explain that he has put his name on the select board 24 ballot, if he does gets elected to the selectboard, he would have to resign from the planning board. 25 However, if he did get voted in as a selectman he would be willing to be the selectboard representative 26 if he was nominated to the position. 27 28 6:45 pm CIP (Capital Improvement Plan) Review – Mason 29 MParker explained that Ken Paulsen took care of the CIP for many years and mentored him to take it 30 over. MParker went over the reasons for the CIP, being to help better use the CRF (Capital Reserve 31 Fund) and prevent large spikes in tax rates for large ticket purchases needed within the town. MParker 32 went over how the CIP works and time frames for completing it. **BHale** stated that he would like to work 33 on the CIP with MParker. 34 35 7:40 pm Public Hearing - DPW Tree Cutting on Cavender Road 36 MParker opened the public hearing and went over the rules for tonight's hearing. MHall confirmed that 37 this public hearing has been property noticed at the town hall, post office, town website and in the 38 newspaper. There were no members of the public attending this hearing. Jim Morris, Roads Foreman of 39 the Greenfield DPW, attended via phone. JMorris explained that he would like cut some hazardous dead 40 and dying trees along the sides of Cavender Road, within the town's right of way. JMorris explained 41 that, while repairing the gravel road, they noticed these trees are posing a danger of coming down at any time. He explained that the tree cutting would be contracted out and any wood that the land 42

owners didn't want would be donated to the fire department and the Transfer Station. JMorris

explained that he would like to have these trees cut down during the cold season as to not damage the

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road. **RMarshall** wanted to make sure that the DPW gets permission from the land owners to take the wood from the fell trees. **JMorris** confirmed that the trees scheduled to be cut are dead, however the town forester has not confirmed. **GRainier** suggested that the large Oak tree near the corner of Old Bennington Road and the Poplar on the right side of the road be added to the list of trees to cut. **GRainier** will meet up with **JMorris** to show the trees he would like added. **MParker** closed the public part of this hearing and the planning board is now in deliberation. **MParker motioned to approve** the tree cutting, including the Poplar and the Oak trees as described, and that Jim obtain approval from the land owners before any wood be removed from the properties. **Seconded by BHale. Motion passed 6-0-0.**
