22	MParker explained that the Chrisenton's will be going before the ZBA soon for an appeal. MParker
23	reminded the planning board that they had approved their LLA. MParker read a draft letter to the ZBA,
24	written with the assistance of town counsel. The planning board discussed further and all agreed with
25	the recommendations to deny the appeal request.

28	MParker explained that EDAC (Economic Development Advisory Committee) would like to get together
29	with the planning board. The planning board discussed where the business district is currently and
30	looked at the current Business District Boundaries within the Zoning Ordinance. The planning board
31	went on to discuss some of the business changes within the town over the years. RMarshall reminded
32	the planning board that the town does have a membership with Southwest Regional Planning, he
33	recommends the planning board use the benefits from this membership more. A discussion followed.
34	The consensus of the planning board is that improved education for the planning board would be a
35	beneficial.
