The Sign's Purpose:

- Public Safety Messages like Amber Alerts, Fire Danger, Floods, Hurricanes, or Shelter Open, Water, Hot Meals, Showers whatever we have available
- Replace the current antiquated Fire Department sign
- Inform the public of events such as Vaccine Clinics, Blood Drives, or CPR classes

Cost:

- There will be **NO** cost for the sign to the taxpayers
- The grant is for \$20,000 with a soft match of our volunteer hours, plus a \$3,391 donation from the Greenfield Firefighters Association (GFA).

Timeline:

- The Selectboard must approve the grant first, then it goes to the Executive Council for approval
- This sign must be purchased and installed this year, or we lose the quoted price/and grant

About the Sign:

- This 3' x 5' sign will not blink, flash, or have videos (The old sign is about 8' long)
- Brightness can/will be controlled especially at night
